### **SERMON NOTES**

### Listening For His Call

Over the past year, all of us have been forced to make changes in the way that we live our lives. There are some people, of course, who are always looking for change and embrace the old saying that says, "A change is as good as a cure."

A positive outlook for today is that in following Jesus; we are given an opportunity for change when we are called to live in the service of God's Word. The Psalmist clearly understood and knew this when he wrote, "Trust in him at all times, for God is our refuge." In his "call to the disciples," it is Jesus who is walking and the fishermen are not aware of him - it is Jesus who sees them. In the same way, Jesus may now or next week be passing along and seeing us, so that his eyes are on us without our realising it.

Whenever the Lord enters our lives, it can be as unexpected and surprising as it was with the Psalmist and the first disciples. We can't make him come, so everything depends on whether we are listening to



his word, and how sensitive we are to his approach.
