# **SERMON NOTES**



Paul, beginning a letter and wishing to identify himself, writes: "Paul a slave of Jesus Christ." The description recurs in the New Testament. It was common and accepted in the early church. A Christian was then, and is now, the "slave of Christ."

Paul looked on the cross and said: "the heart of this world is not law, but love – the very love that sent him into human history, thus to live, and thus to die." Then Paul said: "I do not need to strive or agonise over failure. The strife and the agony are caught up into his love, and I need only to trust him and let him live through me." Then Paul began to sign himself "slave of Christ."

Christianity is not a success story, not the account of One who rose from poverty to a throne, but of a love, which for our sakes came from a throne into our poverty; and the slave is not above his Lord.

<u>Prayer</u>: Lord, we have but one life to live, the life you have given to us, the life you have redeemed. Help us to make the best use of it and not to waste it or fritter it away...
