### **SERMON NOTES**



The first tremendous surprise at the dawn of that day of surprises was finding the empty tomb. What happened?

Some people have thought that the body was removed by Joseph, or that in the early morning, the women mistook the tomb. It is very unlikely that the Roman authorities would have ordered an inquiry into the disappearance of a dead carpenter's body. They would be more likely to laugh at the stories ignorant people believe! The women were terrified and urged Peter and John to come. They rushed to the tomb. They saw and believed. Something deeply impressive was visible; the way in which the grave-clothes lay. What had taken place? In some way unknown to us and inexplicable to science, the physical body of Jesus had disappeared. The disciples saw the linen clothes lying. That is to say, that the Lord had somehow risen because the grave-clothes were undisturbed.

Paul gives us more of a clue to what happened to the body when he declared "Christ has indeed been raised from the dead, the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep."

**PRAYER**: Risen Lord, whose presence is on every road we take in life, in every life that welcomes you, make yourself real to us in hearts kindled with love for you and your cause. Give us and those who keep us safe the assurance of your companionship and victory now and evermore...


